I am writing to you with some good news!



Everyone in Hampshire with a Learning Disability will be offered a Covid-19 vaccination



We will start to offer vaccinations from 1st March



People living in a residential home or supported living will be contacted by their GP



They will be given the vaccination at home by a nurse.



Hampshire County Council will contact people who live with their family or do not have 24 hour support



They will be offered an appointment at a vaccination centre.



If you have an unpaid carer who also needs a vaccination, they can come with you.



After you have booked your vaccination, we will send you a letter with information about:



- Where to go
- How to get there
- What to take with you



- We will also tell you about saying yes/no to your vaccination



When you are contacted we will also check whether you have had your annual LD Health check with your GP.



You may be offered a health check when you have your second vaccination.



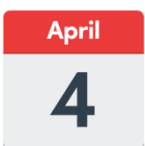
We hope that you are happy with this news
